# 12 JUNE: TERRORISM ACT, NO. 83 OF 1967

The **Terrorism Act** (No. 83 of **1967**) was a security **law** of the apartheid government in **South Africa** which criminalized a broadly defined offence of "**terrorism**". It also gave the police the power to detain people indefinitely, incommunicado and without a trial or court appearance.

# PROTESTS IN THE US AGAINST VIETNAM WAR



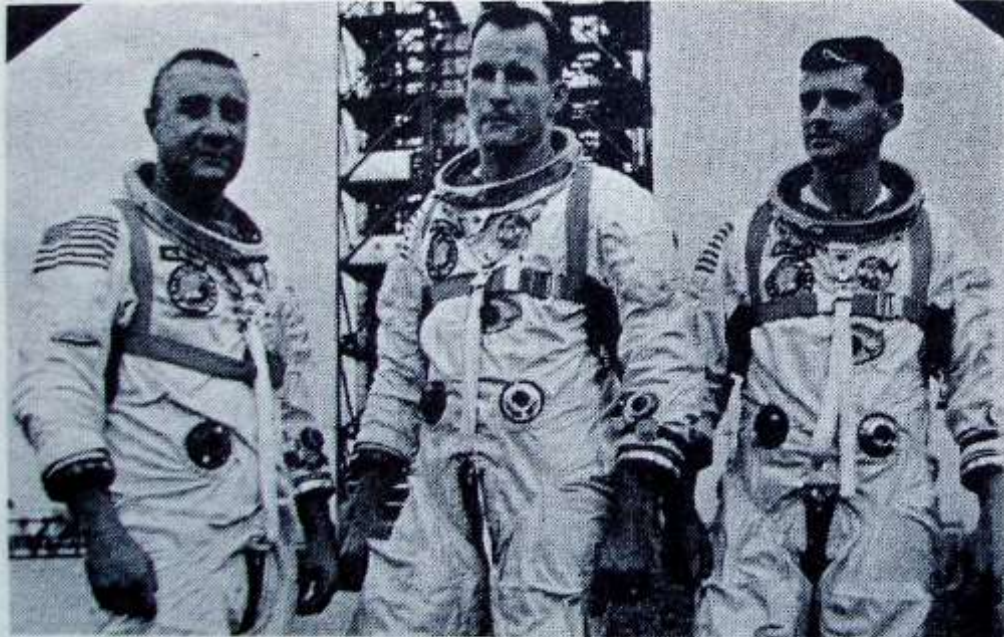
The **Spring Mobilization Committee to End the War in Vietnam**, which became the **National Mobilization Committee to End the War in Vietnam**, was a coalition of antiwar activists formed in 1967 to organize large demonstrations in opposition to the Vietnam War. The organizations were informally known as "the Mobe".

The 20 year war however only ended in 1975, after more than 2 Million souls lost their lives:

- **58,200 Americans/Canadians**
- **4,900 from other countries**
- **2 Million Vietnamese**

# POPE PAUL VI – POPULORUM PROGRESSIO



*Populorum progressio* is the encyclical written by Pope Paul VI on the topic of "the development of peoples" and that the economy of the world should serve mankind and not just the few. It was released on **March 26, 1967**. It touches on a variety of principles of Catholic social teaching: the right to a just wage; the right to security of employment; the right to fair and reasonable working conditions; the right to join a union; and the universal destination of resources and goods.





# MAIDEN FLIGHT OF BOEING 737

Originally envisioned in 1964, the initial 737-100 made its first flight in **April 1967** and entered airline service in February 1968 at Lufthansa.



# GREEK MILITARY JUNTA OF 1967-1974

The military coup by a group of colonels took place on **21 April 1967** and lasted for 7 years. It is commonly known as the **Regime of the Colonels**, or in Greece simply, "**The Junta**".

The dictatorship ended on 24 July 1974 under the pressure of the Turkish invasion of Cyprus establishing the Third Hellenic Republic.



# MARRIAGE OF ELVIS & PRISCILLA PRESLEY

Shortly before Christmas 1966, more than seven years since they first met, Presley proposed to Priscilla Beaulieu.

**They were married on May 1, 1967**, in a brief ceremony in their suite at the Aladdin Hotel in Las Vegas.



# 6 DAY WAR IN ISRAEL

In **May, 1967**, Egyptian and Syrian troops massed on Israel's borders and Egyptian President Gamel Abdal Nasser filled the airwaves with calls to drive the Jews into the sea. The mood in the 19-year-old-country of Israel was bleak. Facing five well-equipped, Soviet trained Arab armies, Israel's defeat was virtually a foregone conclusion.

**Instead of defeat, Israel achieved a stunning victory. On June 5 at 7:46 AM, Israeli planes destroyed the entire Egyptian air force on the ground. In six days, Israel tripled its territory, gaining the Sinai Peninsula, the Golan Heights, the West Bank, and -- most precious of all -- the Old City and the Temple Mount.**

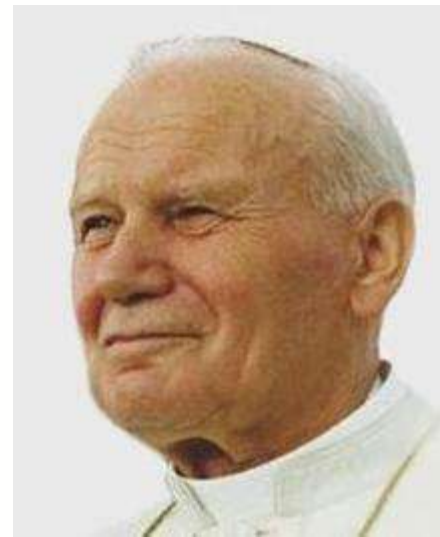




# POPE PAUL VI – ORDAINS 27 NEW CARDINALS
